

## **HERBS**

BASIL	- Rhymes with "dazzle"
Ocimum	- Easily started from seed and will reseed
basilicum	- Has clove-like fragrance and taste
	- Snip leaves frequently to increase yield
	- Used for seasoning vegetables and meat
BORAGE	- Hardy annual
Borago	- Can grow $1-3$ ' tall
officinalis	- Excellent cucumber-like flavor that is good in salad
	- Easily started from seed
	- Flowers are edible and can be candied and used as decoration for baked
	goods or drinks
BAY	- Tender perennial and small shrub
Laurus nobilis	- Prefers bright sun and well-draining soil
	- Difficult to grow indoors
	- Leaves can be picked and dried year round
	- Pleasant fragrance and is used as seasoning in soups, stews, meat, and fish
BEEBALM	- American perennial nicknamed Oswego Tea
	- Has tall, leafy stalk with scarlet fuzzy flowers
	- Considered as a bee and hummingbird attractor
	- Can be utilized in making tea
	- Leaves can be used to flavor apply jelly, fruit cups, and salad
	- Citrus-like fragrance
CARAWAY	- Biennial that produces seeds usually mid-summer of 2 <sup>nd</sup> year
Carum carvi	- Can grow to 24" in height
	- Use young leaves for garnishing or flavoring salads
	- Used to flavor bread, pastries, meat, soups, & salads
	- Has feathery foliage and creamy flowers and also resembles carrots

CAMOMILE	- Best known for its apple-like fragrance
	- Fine cut foliage with a single daisy-like flower
	- Used to make tea that can aid with ailments such as hay fever,
	inflammation, and even muscle spasms, among other things
CATNIP	- Heart-shaped, gray-green leaves
	- Its cousin (Catmint) is a perennial that can grow 2–3'H x 2–3'W
	- Catnip contains an oil that stimulates a cat's pheromones, which gives
	them a sense of euphoria or overwhelming happiness
	- Catnip tea is used to help with nervousness and anxiety
CHERVIL	- Annual herb that can grow up to 2' in height
	- Grows best in moist, but well-draining soil in partial shade
	- Utilize leaves in salads, soups, or even as a garnish
CHIVES	- Almost evergreen perennial of the onion family
	- Prefer rich, well-draining soil and partial to full sun
	- Multiply rapidly and need periodic dividing
	- Used for seasoning soups, salads, stews, and baked potatoes
CORIANDER	- AKA Cilantro or Chinese Parsley
	- Warm spicy flavor that resembles cumin
	- Annual herb that grows 12 to 15" in height
	- Aromatic seeds can be dried and crushed to be used in seasoning sausage,
	beans, stews, cookies, and even wine
	- Young leaves can be used in salads, poultry recipes, pico-de-gallo, and
	also Chinese dishes
